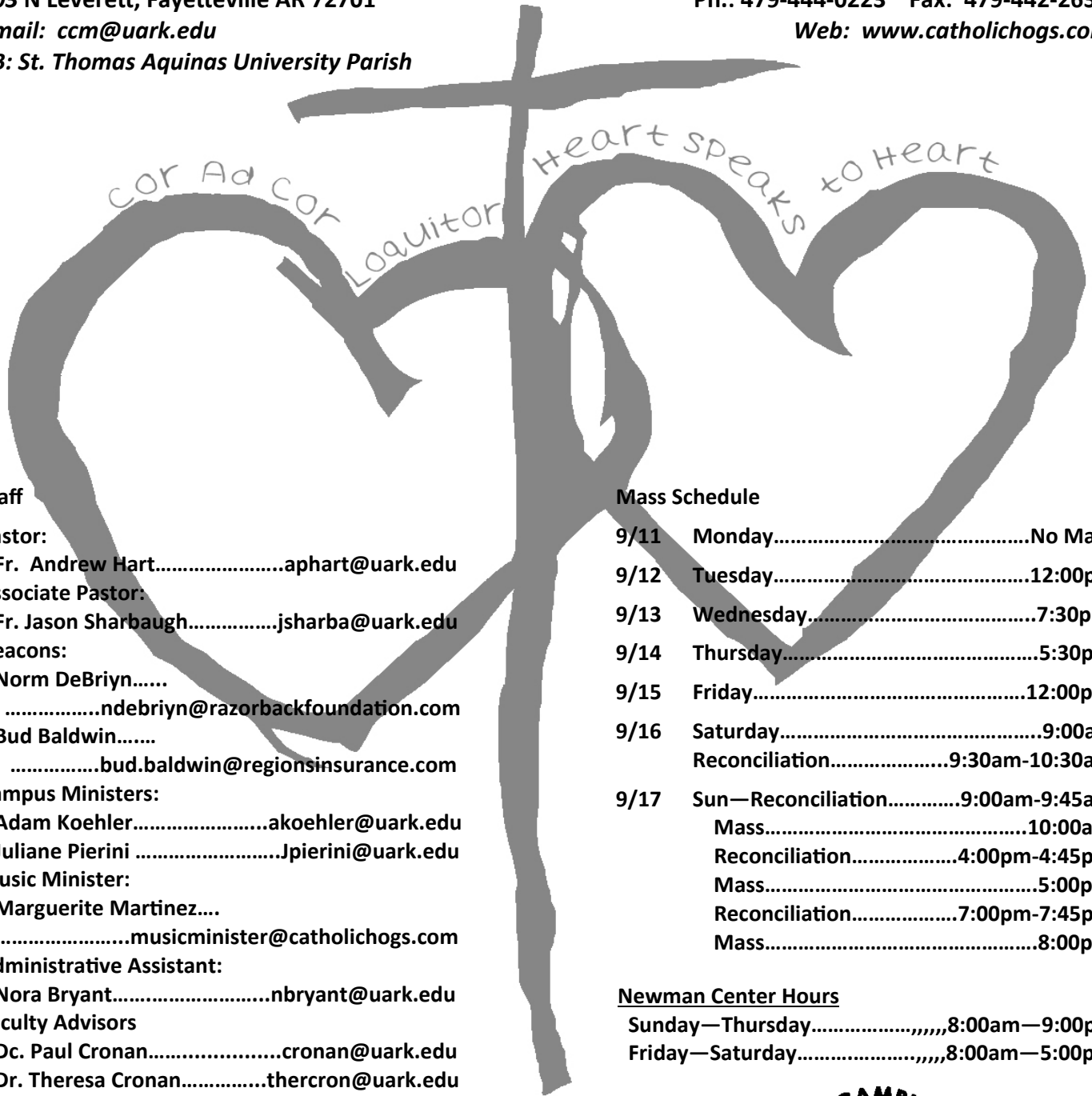

Praise Unplugged is another way to share your gifts.

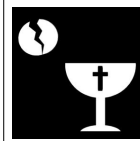
