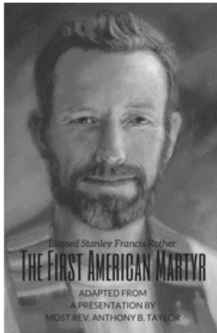
New Book by Bishop Taylor

“Blessed Stanley Francis Rother: The First American Martyr” by Bishop Anthony B. Taylor is now available. The bilingual book is an informative and inspiring account of the life and death of the Oklahoma priest who was murdered for his faith in 1981 in Guatemala. The 88-page book includes eight pages of color photographs from Father Rother’s life and his beatification Mass in September 2017 in Oklahoma City.
